- On your acceptance you will be advised as to when you will start.
- Please note. It is highly unlikely that you will be allocated to the Scout Troop section as we think a break from your current section is strongly advisable and encouraged and therefore it is important that you notify the leadership team if there is any issue with you attending any of the days and times other section meetings are held.
- As EYL's is a Bristol South District provision your current personal information held on OSM (Online Scout Manager), will be shared (electronically) with the District Explorer Team, and you may be contacted directly by them with any relevant Explorer Scout information. (Such as training courses, upcoming events, etc.).
- Parents and Carers will still be able to access the OSM portal and will need to comply with the current procedures for signing up for events and maintaining personal details.
